

Statutory Notice

Chandlers Field Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011, that Surrey County Council, intends to make a prescribed alteration to Chandlers Field Primary School, High Street, West Molesey, Surrey, KT8 2LX from 1 September 2021.

It is proposed that a Special Educational Needs (SEN) Unit for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Conditions (ASC), known locally as a High Communication and Interaction Needs (High COIN) is created at Chandlers Field Primary School. All pupils placed at the SEN Unit by Surrey County Council would have an Education, Health and Care Plan specifying the school as an appropriate placement to meet their individual needs. A bespoke building would be provided for the SEN Unit and located within the school grounds. It is proposed that numbers of pupils on roll at the specialist centre will increase incrementally each year, with 7 places available in September 2021. It will reach its full capacity of 25 places by September 2024.

Surrey County Council has complied with all applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with this proposal. At the conclusion of the Notice period, if permission is granted by the Cabinet Member for All Age Learning, Surrey County Council will implement the proposal.
