## Q&A arising from the consultation to lower the age range at Stamford Green Primary School

1. Will children attending the nursery automatically gain a place in Reception at Stamford Green Primary School once they are school age?	No. Parents of children applying for a reception place would need to apply in the normal way for admission to the primary school whether their child attends the nursery provision or not.  There is no priority for pupils who attend the nursery.  Places at the school are allocated by applying the admissions criteria for community and voluntary controlled schools. The admissions criteria for all schools in Surrey are published each year in the schools admissions booklets. Stamford Green Primary School can be found in the Primary School Booklet for Epsom and Ewell primary schools.	answered 06/05/2021
2. If my child attends the current nursery or has applied to attend the nursery in September 2021 do I need to do anything?	Children who currently attend the nursery or have been allocated a place at the nursery at Stamford Green Primary School will continue to attend the same setting with the same staff and do not need to reapply for a place under the new registration.  There is no change to how parents apply for a nursery place and information can be found on the schools website <a href="https://www.stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk">www.stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk</a> .	06/05/2021
	If your child was born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017 then they will be due to leave the nursery at the end of the Summer term 2021 and you will need to apply for a school place for September 2021. The deadline for applying for a school place was 15 January 2021. If you missed the application process you need to make a late application. If you are unsure if you need to make an application please ask a member of staff at the school or contact the admissions team at Surrey County Council at schooladmissions@surreycc.gov.uk or call 0300 200 1004.	
3. Will there be more pupils on the school site and	There is no planned change to the number of pupils on site at the school as there was a Governor Led nursery on the site of the school which will become the maintained nursery.	06/05/2021

	therefore more traffic in the area?	By lowering the age range of the school, the current nursery will transition to become under the same governance as the school. There is no change in the number of staff or pupils at the site.	
4.	Will there be any changes for staff at the nursery?	Staff at the current nursery are employed by the governing body of Stamford Green Primary School.  All staff will move across under their current terms and conditions to be employed directly by Stamford Green Primary School and Surrey County Council.  There will be opportunities to share resources across the whole school which will improve the training and development opportunities for staff in the nursery and across the whole	06/05/2021
