



Statutory Notice

Freemantles School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011, that Surrey County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Freemantles School, Smarts Heath Road, Mayford Green, Woking GU22 0AN from 1 September 2021.

It is proposed to expand Freemantles School from 1 form of entry at Reception Year to 2 forms of entry at Reception Year, from September 2021. The school works with children and young people with Complex Social Communication Needs and Autism Spectrum Conditions, and currently admits 9 pupils per year group in Reception Year to Year 11 and 8 pupils in Years 12 to 14. As a result of this proposal, the numbers would increase by 9 pupils per year group across the whole school (Years R to 14) from September 2021 onwards. Numbers at the expanded school will grow incrementally and will take into account the additional pupils already attending the school in the temporary bulge classes. It is expected that the expanded school will reach its new full capacity of 270 by September 2028.

Surrey County Council has complied with all applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with this proposal. At the conclusion of the Notice period, if permission is granted by the Surrey Cabinet Member for All-Age Learning, Surrey County Council will implement the proposal.

A building project will be undertaken on the existing site to provide the necessary additional capacity, for which the appropriate planning approval will be sought.
