



### **Statutory Notice**

#### **Hawkedale Infants – A Foundation School, Stratton Road, Sunbury-on-Thames TW16 6PG**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011, that the governing body intends to make a significant change to Hawkedale Infants – A Foundation School, Stratton Road, Sunbury-on-Thames TW16 6PG.

It is proposed to expand Hawkedale Infants from a single form of entry (1FE) infant school to a single form of entry (1FE) all through primary school. The change would come into effect from September 2017, with the school reaching full capacity in September 2020. The school's number on roll would increase from 90 pupils to 210 pupils.

The proposed change will take effect from September 2017 when the 2016-17 Year 2 pupils move up to Year 3. The school would grow incrementally year on year as each successive year an additional class in Key Stage 2 would fill up. It would therefore be a full primary school of 210 by September 2020.

At the same time Springfield Primary School (an academy in the GLF Schools multi academy trust) is planning to increase its infant Published Admission Number to 60 (2FE), and will expand to a two form of entry (2FE) primary school by 2019. These related proposals will together provide the additional form of entry (1FE) from Reception to Year 6 needed in the Sunbury-on-Thames planning area.

A building project will be undertaken on the existing Hawkedale Infants site to provide the necessary additional accommodation, for which the relevant planning permissions are currently being sought.

The school's admission arrangements will not be changed. The transport arrangements for the school will be in accordance with Surrey County Council's current school transport policy.

The governing body of Hawkedale Infants and Surrey County Council have complied with all applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with this proposal. At the conclusion of the Notice period, if the project funding is agreed by the Surrey County Council Cabinet, the proposal will be implemented. It is intended that the school will promote cohesion of the local community that it serves by providing additional primary school places and, through extended services, enhance the well-being and future opportunities of children in the area.
