



Statutory Notice

Hinchley Wood Primary School, Claygate Lane, Hinchley Wood, Surrey, KT10 0AQ

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011, that Surrey County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Hinchley Wood Primary School, Claygate Lane, Hinchley Wood, Surrey, KT10 0AQ.

It is proposed to permanently enlarge Hinchley Wood Primary School from two forms of entry (2FE) to three forms of entry (3FE) with effect from September 2016. A form of entry is normally 30 pupils. This will increase the capacity of the school from 420 to 630.

The proposed change will take effect from September 2016 when the school will admit 90 pupils at Reception entry. The school would grow incrementally year on year as each successive Reception intake would be 90 pupils. The school have already admitted bulge intakes in Reception of 90 pupils in 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014, and are likely to do so in 2015 in order to meet the local demand for places. It will therefore reach its new 3FE capacity in every year group by September 2017.

A building project will be undertaken on the existing site to provide the necessary additional capacity, for which the relevant planning permissions are currently being applied.

The school's admission arrangements will not be changed. The transport arrangements for the school will be in accordance with Surrey County Council's current school transport policy.

Surrey County Council has complied with all applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with this proposal. At the conclusion of the Notice period, if permission is granted by The Surrey Cabinet Member for Schools and Learning, Surrey County Council will implement the proposal. It is intended that the school will promote cohesion of the local community that it serves by providing additional primary school places and, through extended services, enhance the well-being and future opportunities of children in the area.
