



Statutory Notice

North East Surrey Secondary Short Stay School, Stanwell New Road, Staines, Middlesex TW18 4HZ

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Surrey County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to the North East Surrey Secondary Short Stay School, currently located at 174 Molesey Road, Hersham KT12 4 QY and at West Hill Epsom KT19 8HR.

It is proposed to relocate part of this provision to Stanwell New Road, Staines, Middlesex TW18 4HZ with effect from April 2015. Renovation and internal refurbishment will be necessary at Stanwell New Road in order to render the provision appropriate to the needs of older pupils.

The current capacity of the NE Surrey Short Stay School will remain unchanged. The school will continue to operate over two sites with an overall capacity of 60 Full Time Equivalent places spread between both sites. The Epsom site will close. The Stanwell New Road site will replace this provision and accommodate a maximum of 35 students.

All applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with the proposals have been complied with. Surrey County Council will implement the proposal. It is intended that the school will be consolidated onto two sites. The proposal will satisfy the local need for places in an alternative learning provision.

The transport arrangements for the school will be in accordance with Surrey County Council's current school transport policy.
