



## **Statutory Notice**

### **Closure of Ripley CofE Primary School, Wentworth close, Ripley, Surrey GU23 6ED**

Notice is given in accordance with section 15 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 (as amended by the Education Act 2011) and the School Organisation (Establishment and Discontinuance of Schools) Regulations 2013 that Surrey County Council, in consultation with the Diocese of Guildford, is proposing to discontinue Ripley CofE Primary School with effect from 31 August 2018.

All children attending Ripley CofE Primary School at the time the decision is effective, would be offered places at alternative schools in the area. The school currently has 38 children on roll, 29 of which would require primary school places in September.

Free transport would be provided for eligible pupils provided they meet the criteria. The criteria can be found on the Surrey County Council website at:
