

Statutory Notice

ST PAULS C OF E INFANT SCHOOL

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011, that Surrey County Council, intends to make a prescribed alteration to St Paul's CofE Infant School, The Cardinals, Tongham, Farnham GU10 1EF.

Surrey County Council are proposing to expand the premises of St Paul's CofE Infant School in order to accommodate the proposed change in age range from 4 to 7 years to 2 to 11 years to become St Paul's CofE Primary School and nursery. It is proposed that the nursery provision will open in April 2024 to replace a previous provision which closed in August 2023. It is proposed that the school will become a primary school from 1 September 2025. As a result, the school will be enlarged from a 90 place infant school, offering 30 places per year from Year R to Year 2, to a 210 place primary school, offering 30 places per year from Year R to Year 6 with a 68 place nursery provision, depending on the needs of the community. St Paul's CofE Infant School is a Voluntary Controlled School.

This prescribed alteration is linked to the proposal by the Governing Body of St Paul's CofE Infant School to change the age range of the school from 4-7 years to 2-11 years as per the dates outlined above.

Surrey County Council has complied with all applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with this proposal. At the conclusion of the Notice period, if permission is granted by the Cabinet Member for Education and Learning, Surrey County Council will implement the proposal.
