



Statutory Notice

The Priory Church of England (Aided) School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011, that the Governing Body of The Priory CE (Aided) School in co-operation with Surrey County Council, and Guildford Diocesan Board of Education, intends to make a prescribed alteration to The Priory CE (Aided) School, West Bank, Dorking, RH4 3DG from 1 September 2022.

It is proposed that The Priory CE (Aided) School will close its sixth form provision from September 2022. The proposal will change the age range in the school from 11 to 18 years, to 11 to 16 years.

Current National Curriculum Year 12 students would complete their education at The Priory CE (Aided) School and the proposed closure would have no impact on current National Curriculum Year 13 students.

Surrey County Council has complied with all applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with this proposal. At the conclusion of the Notice period, if permission is granted by the Surrey Cabinet Member for All-Age Learning, Surrey County Council will implement the proposal.
