



Statutory Notice

HURST GREEN INFANT SCHOOL & NURSERY

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, as amended by the Education Act 2011 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, that Surrey County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Hurst Green Infant School and Nursery, Wolfs Wood, Oxted RH8 0HJ from 1 January 2024.

Surrey County Council in partnership with the Governing Body of Hurst Green Infant School and Nursery are proposing to lower the age range of Hurst Green Infant School in Tandridge from 3 to 7 years to 2 to 7 years. This would mean that the current nursery provision for 2 year olds led by the Governing Body would become part of the maintained nursery managed by the school, under the same Ofsted registration as the school

Surrey County Council has complied with all applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with this proposal. At the conclusion of the Notice period, if permission is granted by the Surrey Cabinet Member for Education and Learning, Surrey County Council will implement the proposal.
