

Statutory Notice

**Stoughton Infant School, Stoughton Road, Guildford, Surrey,
GU2 9ZT**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Surrey County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Stoughton Infant School, Stoughton Road, Guildford, Surrey, GU2 9ZT.

It is proposed to enlarge the school by one form of entry (from two forms of entry to three forms of entry) to provide capacity for 270 pupils.

The proposed changes will take effect from September 2015. From September 2014, there will be 3 'bulge' classes in addition to the 2 forms of entry permanently accommodated; therefore from September 2014, the school will have capacity for 270 pupils.

The proposal will permanently increase the published admissions number (PAN) from 60 to 90 from September 2015. Three forms of entry will be admitted in September 2015, and the two subsequent years; the school will be a full capacity, three form entry infant school from September 2017.

All applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with the proposals have been complied with. Surrey County Council will implement the proposal.

The proposal to expand the school is in response to the local demand for primary school places. It forms part of a borough wide expansion programme to provide a sufficiency of school places.

The transport arrangements for the schools will be in accordance with Surrey County Council's current school transport policy.
