

**Notice**  
**Surrey County Council**  
**(Various Roads in Farnham) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 202-**

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 “the Act” (as amended) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to impose a 50mph speed limit in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The speed limits proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011. A copy of the proposed Order, a plan showing the lengths of roads to which the Order relates, and a Statement of the Council’s reasons for proposing to make the Order and a Statement of the Council’s guidelines on the acceptance of objections to Traffic Regulation Orders may be viewed:

**The Schedule**

1. Alton Road (A31) Farnham – that length which extends from the boundary of Hampshire County Council and Surrey County Council to its junction with A31 Coxbridge Roundabout;
2. Coxbridge Roundabout (A31) Farnham – its entire length;
3. Farnham By-Pass (A31) Farnham – that length which extends from its junction with A31 Coxbridge Roundabout to a point 200 metres west of the western highway boundary of D5137 Weydon Lane.
