Surrey County Council Aarons Hill (D5424) Godalming (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), the effect of which will be to prohibit all motor vehicles from entering or proceeding in That length of Aarons Hill (D5424), Godalming, as extends along the entirety of the access road serving Nos. 11, 13, 15 and 17 Aarons Hill. The proposed Order will not apply in relation to the following – (1) For the purpose of gaining access to or leaving any land or premises and/or land accessible only from the length of road specified herein; (2) To enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from that vehicle; (3) Ambulance, fire brigade or police vehicles in an emergency; (4) Vehicles under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or of a sign placed pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Act; (5) Pedal cycles; (6) Invalid carriages; (7) For the following operations, when necessary only - (a) Building industrial or demolition purposes; (b) The removal of any obstruction to traffic; (c) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road; (d) In connection with works on any sewer, gas, water, electricity or telecommunications system; (8) In the service of a local authority or water authority; (9) Vehicles operated by the Post Office for the purpose of any of their functions.
