## Surrey County Council Proposed Road Table

## in Access to Rainbow Leisure Centre, Epsom

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) of the Highways Act 1980 have introduced a physical measure to improve road safety and reduce vehicle speeds in the unnamed access road to Rainbow Leisure Centre, Epsom. The flat-topped road table, which is situated at a point 8.05m from the centre point of East Street, extends across the carriageway. The road table is 75mm in height, 4.5m in length and 7m wide, with a 1.5m long ramp at a gradient of 1:20.
