As a result of the highway works described above, the existing speed national speed limit on the A281 need to be changed as follows (extents described from north to south):

- <u>50mph</u> from position 205m approx. south of Elmbridge Road (existing DR/40 sign) for approximately 1445m, then changing to 40mph
- <u>40mph</u> continuing southbound for 740m approx. to position 50m approx. south of Alfold Road, then changing to 50mph
- <u>50mph</u> for 1050m approx. to position 275m approx. north of Alfold Crossways (existing 40/DR sign), then reverting to existing 40mph

SPEED LIMITS TO APPLY IN BOTH DIRECTIONS
