Surrey County Council Propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to amend The Borough of Spelthorne (C235 Ashford Road, Ashford Common) 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1994, so as to revoke that part of the 40 mph speed limit imposed on Ashford Road (C235), Ashford, as extends from its junction with Spelthorne Lane to a point 50m north-west if the said junction. The overall effect of the amendment will be that such length of Ashford Road will become subject to a 30mph speed limit by reason of the provision of a system of street lighting, pursuant to Sections 81(1) and 82(1) of the Act. The speed limit proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.
