SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL - BOROUGH OF GUILDFORD

PROPOSED PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL LENGTHS OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS

APPLYING AT ANY TIME IN CERTAIN LENGTHS OF THE D4010 BOXGROVE LANE,

GUILDFORD

1. **Surrey County Council (“The County Council”)** Propose to Make The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Guildford (Guildford Town Area Outside of the Guildford Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions Street Parking Places and Revocation) Amendment Order (Number_) 201_ under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35 and 36 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, the purpose and effect of which will be to -

- (a) prohibit the waiting by vehicles at any time of the day or night throughout the week in that length of the:
- north-west side of Boxgrove Lane, Guildford which extends from a point 20 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Cunningham Avenue north-eastwards to the common boundary of number 21 Boxgrove Lane and the premises occupied by “The Bright Horizons Day Nursery and Preschool”, a distance of approximately 24 metres; and
 - south-east side of Boxgrove Lane, Guildford which extends from a point 39 metres north-east of a point opposite the common boundary of numbers 15 and 17 Boxgrove Lane north-eastwards to a point opposite the common boundary of number 21 Boxgrove Lane and the premises occupied by “The Bright Horizons Day Nursery and Preschool”, a distance of approximately 34 metres;
- (b) provide that in the lengths of Boxgrove Lane, Guildford described in sub-paragraph (a) above, the usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of road, the maintenance of that road and the services in it and for disabled persons’ vehicles in accordance with the “Blue Badge” Scheme would apply;
- (c) carry out a legal drafting amendment regarding the existing no waiting at any time restrictions situated in that length of the south-east side of Boxgrove Lane which extends from a point 9 metres north-east of a point opposite the common boundary of numbers 17 and 19 Boxgrove Lane north-eastwards for a distance of 30 metres (that length of Boxgrove Lane lying opposite its junction with Cunningham Avenue)

and which amendment will not affect those restrictions in any way whatsoever.

2. A copy of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the lengths of road to which that Order relates, The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Guildford (Guildford Town Area Outside of the Guildford Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions Street Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2004 (and the Orders which have amended that Order) (and the plans which accompany those sealed Orders), a Statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and a Statement of the County Council's Guidelines for the Acceptance of Objections to Traffic Regulation Orders may be inspected, free of charge, at:
