Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in Castle Hill (D4015) Guildford

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Castle Hill (D4015) Guildford. The road tables and their locations are as detailed below. Each road table will be flat topped, extend across the carriageway (with tapered edge), and will be 65mm in height, 4m in length and will have 1.5m long ramps at a gradient of 1:20.

- (a) The centre line of the proposed road table will be situated at a point 5.2m east of the common boundary between property numbers 3 and 7;
- (b) The centre line of the proposed road table will be situated at a point 9.9m south of the common boundary between property numbers 1 and 3.
