Chalk Lane (D262) and The Drift (D246) East Horsley
(30 Mph Speed Limit) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above-named Order, under Section 81, 82, 83, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to

- (a) impose a 30 miles per hour maximum speed limit in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
- (b) carry out legal drafting amendments to “The Surrey County Council Ockham Road North (B2039) Ockham Road South (B2039) and The Drift (D246) East Horsley (Restricted Roads and 40mph Speed Limit) (Amendment) Order 2003” (hereinafter referred to as the “Order of 2003”) so as to omit the item relating to The Drift (D246) East Horsley in the First Schedule of the said Order of 2003 from that Schedule

No speed limit imposed by the above-mentioned Order shall apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the provisions of The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.

- (2) that length of The Drift (D246) East Horsley as extends from a point 26m northeast of the north-eastern kerb line of (B2039) Ockham Road North to its junction with (C42) Forest Road
