Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming Measures in Chertsey Road (C233) Ashford

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Chertsey Road (C233), Ashford. The type of physical measures and their locations are as follows. Two abreast speed cushions at the following locations in Chertsey Road, measured from the centre line of the cushions – (1) 4.9m south-west of the property boundary of Nos. 6 and 8 Chertsey Road; (2) 4.75m south-west of the property boundary of Nos. 28 and 30 Chertsey Road; (3) 3.75m south-west of the property boundary of Nos. 47a and 49 Chertsey Road; (4) 0.43m south-west of the property boundary of Nos. 61 and 63 Chertsey Road; (5) 2m south-west of the property boundary of Nos. 9 Hendon Terrace; and (6) 4.45m south-west of the property boundary of Nos. 74 and 76 Chertsey Road. The cushions will be 75mm high (flat topped), 3.5m long and 1.7m wide.
