Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming Measures and Raised Zebra Crossing in Bagshot Road (A319) Chobham

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to introduce: -

- (a) a pair of new speed cushions in Bagshot Road (A319) Chobham the centreline of which will be located 8.96 metres west of the common boundary between the properties No.1 Holly Bank Bagshot Road and No.2 Elm Bank Bagshot Road. The proposed speed cushions will be flat topped and will measure 75 millimetres in height, 3.5 metres in length and 1.65 metres wide with 600mm long main ramps at a gradient of 1:8 and 300mm long side ramps at a gradient of 1:4; and
- (b) a raised Zebra Crossing in Bagshot Road (A319) Chobham, the centreline of which will be located 21 metres west of the western edge of the separation island in Bagshot Road in the vicinity of the mini roundabout at the junction of (A319) Bagshot Road, (A319) High Street and (A3046) High Street. The Zebra Crossing will extend 2.4 metres in width and be placed on a flat top raised table, which will extend across the full width of the carriageway. The proposed raised table will be 75 millimetres in height, 10.27 metres overall in length with a 7.27 metre flat top and 1.5 metre ramps at a 1:20 gradient.
