Church Lane (D151) Witley
(20 mph Speed Limit) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 “the Act” (as amended) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to impose a 20mph speed limit in that length of Church Lane (D151) Witley which extends from its junction with A283 Petworth Road to its junction with X151 Churchfields. The speed limit proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.
