

**SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL  
PROPOSED PROVISION OF A TOUCAN CROSSING  
IN PORTSMOUTH ROAD (A307) COBHAM**

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to establish a Toucan Crossing on Portsmouth Road (A307), Cobham, 77m west of its junction with Fairmile Lane. The crossing will be 6m wide.
