Surrey County Council Station Road North (D7025) Egham (Prohibition of Vehicles) (No. 2) Order 2023

On 17 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above named Order, under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), which will come into force on 21 January 2023. The effect of which will be to prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Station Road North (D7025) Egham, as extends from its junction with Church Road for a distance of 130m, at any time. The Council is satisfied that for preventing danger to persons using the said road it is requisite that Section 3(1)(b) of the Act shall not apply in relation to this Order.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
