

**Surrey County Council
Station Road North (D7025) Egham
(Prohibition of Vehicles) (No. 2) Order 202-**

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), the effect of which will be to prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Station Road North (D7025) Egham, as extends from its junction with Church Road for a distance of 130m, at any time. The Council is satisfied that for preventing danger to persons using the said road it is requisite that Section 3(1)(b) of the Act shall not apply in relation to this Order.
