

Surrey County Council
Amendments to Waiting and Loading Restrictions
And On-Street Parking Places in the District of Tandridge

On 19 September 2024 and 14 November 2024 Surrey County Council proposed to make “The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Amendment of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and On-Street Parking Places Orders) (Amendment No.1) Order 202-” pursuant to Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the purpose and effect of which will be to make certain amendments to the waiting and parking restrictions in the District of Tandridge. The Council now proposes to make the following further amendment to the Orders quoted in the said Notices so as to prohibit waiting at any time by vehicles in a certain length of Croydon Road, Caterham.

Exemptions for loading on and unloading from vehicles, boarding, and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining the lengths of road referred to above, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for disabled persons’ vehicles in accordance with the Blue Badge Scheme, will apply to the aforementioned restrictions.

Where a restriction is proposed herein any existing restriction on the same length of road will be revoked, unless otherwise indicated.
