## Surrey County Council Proposed Raised Tables in Colin Road (D1430), Mount Pleasant Road (D1430) and Crescent Road (D1431), Caterham

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police propose to introduce new road tables as part of the continuous footway scheme in Colin Road (D1430), Mount Pleasant Road (D1430) and Crescent Road (D1431), Caterham, the locations and details of which are specified and described below:

## (1) Colin Road (D1430) Caterham

A raised table, the centreline of which will be located 1.9 metres from its junction with (B2208) Croydon Road. The proposed road table will extend across the full width of the carriageway and will be 70mm in height on the western ramp and 65 millimetres in height on the eastern ramp, 2.4 metres overall in length with a 1.8 metre flat top. Both ramps will be 300 millimetres in length.

## (2) Mount Pleasant Road (D1430) Caterham

A raised table, the centreline of which will be located 3.34 metres from its junction with (B2208) Croydon Road. The proposed road table will extend across the full width of the carriageway and will be 65mm in height on the western ramp and 60 millimetres in height on the eastern ramp, 3.0 metres overall in length with a 2.4 metre flat top. Both ramps will be 300 millimetres in length.

## (3) Crescent Road (D1431), Caterham

A raised table, the centreline of which will be located 4.05 metres from its junction with (B2208) Croydon Road and (B2208) The Square. The proposed road table will extend across the full width of the carriageway and will be 15mm in height on the western ramp and 25 millimetres in height on the eastern ramp, 3.0 metres overall in length with a 2.4 metre flat top. Both ramps will be 300 millimetres in length.
