

Notice - The Surrey County Council
D3282 High Street, Staines Upon Thames (Prohibition of Entry)
Pedestrianisation Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order under Section 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to: - **1.** Prohibit all vehicles, including pedal cycles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of D3282 High Street, Staines Upon Thames - from its junction with A308 Thames Street and A308 High Street, to its junction with A308 South Street and D6362 Mustard Mill Road, at any time except for loading between the hours of midnight to 9:30am and 5:00pm to midnight on Monday to Saturday and all day on Sundays – to be signed as a Pedestrian Zone. **2.** Prohibit all vehicles, including pedal cycles proceeding in A308 South Street and D6362 Mustard Mill Road, Staines Upon Thames from entering D3282 High Street at the junction of the said roads. **3.** Revoke “The Borough of Spelthorne (High Street, Staines (Between its junction with Thames Street and South Street))(Restricted Traffic) Order 2001” in its entirety.

The prohibitions and restrictions specified above in sub-sections **1.** and **2.** above shall not apply to vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; or in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the road in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Act.

The prohibitions and restrictions specified above in sub-section **1.** above shall not apply to: - **1.** A powered wheelchair or an invalid carriage; **2.** Any person on foot pushing a pedal cycle; **3.** If it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used in connection with the following operations namely: - **a)** Building industrial or demolition operations; **b)** The removal of any obstruction to traffic; **c)** The maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of road referred to above or of any part/parts thereof; **d)** In connection with the laying erection alteration or repair in or in land adjacent to the road or any part thereof of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any apparatus provided under the Telecommunications Act 1984; **4.** If it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; **5.** To be used in the service of a universal service provider to deliver or collect postal packets as defined in Section 125 (1) of the Postal services Act 2000 to premises within the length of D3282 High Street, Staines Upon Thames specified above or accessible only therefrom. **6.** For market traders on the days and at the times that the “Staines Market” operates.
