The Surrey County Council Duke Street (D3662) Woking (Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022

On 8 February 2022 Surrey County Council make the above-named Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), which will come into force on 12 February 2022, the effect of which will be to prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Duke Street (D3662), Woking, as extends from its junction with Locke Way to its junction with Maybury Road. The prohibition will not apply in relation to: - (1) Ambulance, fire brigade or police vehicles in an emergency; (2) Vehicles under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or of a sign placed pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Act; (3) Pedal cycles; (4) Invalid carriages; (5) Where necessary for (a) Building industrial or demolition purposes; (b) The removal of any obstruction to traffic; (c) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road; (d) In connection with works on any sewer, gas, water, electricity or telecommunications system.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained within it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the date of making the Order, apply to The High Court for this purpose.
