Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming in Farleigh Road (C217) Warlingham

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a physical measure to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Farleigh Road (C217) Warlingham. The type of physical measure and location is – a road table which will extend across the full width of the road, will be 4m with 1.1m ramps long and 75mm high centred 99.5m from its junction with Sunny Bank.
