Proposed Provision of Pedex Pedestrian Crossings in Farnham

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to install controlled signalised pedestrian facilities (Pedex Crossings), with far-side indicators, as follows: -

- 1)** A287 Union Road, Farnham – Proposed Pedex Crossing to be 9.84m in length at its centreline and 4m in width. The centreline to be located 8.36m south-west of the corner of the boundary wall of “Gostrey House” on its northern side, and 2.74m north-east of the southern stone pillar gatepost to “Gostrey Meadow” on the south side.
- 2)** A287 Longbridge, Farnham – Proposed Pedex Crossing to be 11.8m in length at its centreline and 4m wide. The centreline to be located 10.14m south-east of the north-west corner of the boundary fencing of “Hawthorn Lodge” at the junction of A287 Longbridge and A287 Downing Street on its western side, and 0.32m south-west of the northern corner of the southern stone pillar gatepost to “Gostrey Meadow” on its eastern side.
- 3)** B3228 West Street, Farnham – Proposed Pedex Crossing to be 8.49m in length at its centreline and 4m wide. The centreline to be located 5.43m south-west of the south-western corner of the entrance to “No.121 West Street” on its northern side, and 2.52m west of the northern corner of the entrance to “No.1 West Street” at its junction with Downing Street on its southern side.
- 4)** A287 Downing Street, Farnham – Proposed Pedex Crossing to be 4.13m in length at its centreline and 4m wide. The centreline to be located 6.16m north-west of the south-eastern corner of the entrance to “No.1 West Street” on its western side, and 3.86m north-east of the southern corner of the entrance to “No.51 The Borough” at its junction with Downing Street on its eastern side.
- 5)** A287 The Borough, Farnham – Proposed Pedex Crossing to be 8.42m in length at its centreline and 4m wide. The centreline to be located 2.50m south-west of the north-eastern corner of “No.1 The Borough” on its northern side, and 1.54m south of the northern corner of the entrance to “No.51 The Borough” at its junction with Downing Street on its southern side.
- 6)** B3228 Bear Lane, B3228 East Street, A287 The Borough and A287 South Street, Farnham (the “Royal Deer Junction”) – Proposed Diagonal Pedex Crossing to be 10.07m in length at its centreline and 4m wide. The centreline to be located 1.18m south of the northern corner of the entrance to “No.21 The Borough” on its western side, and 0.06m north-east of the north-west corner of “No.4 South Street” at its junction with East Street on its eastern side.
