Notice Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Farnham (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 "the Act" (as amended) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to -

- (a) impose a 20mph speed limit in the lengths of roads specified in The Schedule to this Notice. The speed limit proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011;
- (b) carry out legal drafting amendments to "The Surrey County Council Weydon Lane (D5317) Farnham (20mph Speed Limit and 30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2005" so as to omit the Schedule imposing a 30mph in Weydon Lane, in its entirety.

- (e) Green Lane, Farnham from its junction with Weydon Lane south for a distance of 35 metres
- Bardsley Drive, Farnham from its junction with Weydon Lane, south for a distance of 24 metres
