Surrey County Council Amendments to Waiting and Parking Restrictions in the Borough of Waverley

- (a) Prohibit the waiting by vehicles in certain lengths of the roads specified in the First Schedule to this Notice, during the times and on the days indicated therein, and provide that the usual exceptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, for works on or adjoining the lengths of roads referred to in the said schedule, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the Blue Badge Scheme, would apply.
