Surrey County Council Proposed Traffic Calming Measures in Ormside Way (D1262) and Frenches Road (C224), Redhill

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Ormside Way (D1262) and Frenches Road (C224), Redhill, as follows: -

One set of two Speed cushions in Ormside Way, Redhill, 4m north-east (5.75m to centre) of the bell mouth of the Ormside Way junction with Frenches Road:

One set of two Speed cushions in Ormside Way, Redhill, 6.35m south-east (8.15m to centre) of the radius kerb forming the bell mouth of the Frenches Road/Ormside Way junction;

One set of two speed cushions in Frenches Road, Redhill, 11.50m north-east (13.20m to centre) of the northern kerbline of the access into No. 211 Frenches Road

The speed cushions will measure 3.5m long and 1.7m wide (including 0.6m ramps) and 750mm high.
