Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in Gatton Park Road (A242) Redhill

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Gatton Park Road (A242) Redhill, as follows: -

Five 7.5m long flat top road tables 75mm in height with 1.5m ramps at 1:20 gradient. The tables will extend across the full width of the carriageway, except Number (4), which will have a tapered edge and will be centred at the following locations: -

- (1) 24.5m south-west of the centre of the junction with Colesmead Road;
- (2) 12.8m north-east of the centre of the entrance to Gatton Park Court;
- (3) 1.7m east of the common property boundary of No. 55 Gatton Park Road and Flat Nos 25-38 Parkside Court;
- (4) 12m south-west of the common property boundary of Nos. 19 and 21 Gatton Park Road;
- (5) 4.1m north-east of the common property boundary of Nos. 3 and 5 Gatton Park Road.

Two sets of two speed cushions measuring 1.7m in width, 75mm high and 3.5m long, with main ramps 0.6m in length with a gradient of 1:8 and side ramps 0.3m long with a gradient of 1:4, centred at the following locations: -

- (1) 2.4m south-west of the common property boundary of Nos. 91 and 93 Gatton Park Road;
- (2) 2.4m west of the common property boundary of Nos. 71 and 73 Gatton Park Road.
