

Surrey County Council
Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in Gibbet Lane (D3509) Camberley

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Gibbet Lane (D3509), Camberley. The four road tables will have a 4m long flat top and 1.125m slopes (1 in 15) and will be 75mm high, located at the following locations, (measured from the northern edge) -

- (1) 25m south of the junction with London Road, extending for the full width of the road;
- (2) 18.3m south of the start of the one-way system, measuring 2.4m wide with .225m side ramps (1 in 3 slope);
- (3) 100m south of the start of the one-way system, measuring 2.4m wide with .225m side ramps (1 in 3 slope);
- (4) 33m north of the junction with Crawley Ridge, measuring 2.4m wide with .225m side ramps (1 in 3 slope);
