Proposed reduction of the existing 40mph Speed Limit to a 30mph Speed Limit on a

length of A322 Guildford Road, Bisley/West End

D31 Queens Road, Bisley and C12 Limecroft Road, Bisley/Knaphill

Statement of Reasons

Residents and the Divisional Member have raised concerns about vehicle speeds, road safety, and the appropriateness of the existing 40mph speed limit along the A322 Guildford Road through Bisley and West End.

In response to the concerns raised, a speed limit assessment has been completed in accordance with Surrey County Council's Setting Local Speed Limits policy. As part of this process, speed surveys were carried out at various locations in each of the roads.

The findings of the assessment indicate the proposed reduction in speed limit from 40mph to 30mph over the section of the A322 shown on the attached plans is appropriate, and Surrey Police has confirmed it has no objections to the proposal.

21 personal injury collisions occurred in the 3 years between 1 May 2020 and 30 April 2023 over the section of the A322 Guildford where the 30mph speed limit is proposed.

The proposed reduction in speed limit will help improve road safety and will ensure that the roads are subject to speed limits that are appropriate and consistent with Surrey County Council's Setting Local Speed Limits Policy.

As indicated on the attached plan and public notice, the proposals also include a reduction in speed limit from 40mph to 30mph over short lengths of the C12 Limecroft Road and the D31 Queens Road. This is for the following reasons:

- to avoid a short length of Limecroft Road being left subject to a 40mph, which would be inconsistent with the adjacent lengths of road and potentially confusing for drivers.
- so the start of the 30mph speed limit in Queens Road is located a sufficient distance from its junction with the A322 Guildford Road to ensure the 30mph signs are clearly visible to motorists.
