SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURE IN HEATH ROAD (B374) AND BROOKLANDS LANE (D3883) WEYBRIDGE

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a physical measure to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in Heath Road (B374) and Brooklands Lane (D3883), Weybridge. The type of physical measure and location is as follows. A road table which will extend across the full width of the road, 39m long extending along Heath Road, north from a point 1m south of the southern building line of No. 37 Heath Road and extending for a distance of 16m into Brooklands Lane (D3883). The road table will measure 75mm high with ramps at a gradient of 1:15.
