## Surrey County Council Proposed Raised Zebra Crossing High Street (D3809) Walton-On-Thames

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to introduce a raised Zebra Crossing on High Street (D3809), Walton-On-Thames, which will be located 73m north-west of the prolongation of the of the north-western kerb line of Churchfield Road. The Zebra crossing will extend 4m in width and be placed on a flat-topped raised table, which will extend across the full width of the carriageway, rise to a height of 75 millimetres and measure 7.5m long, with 1.5m ramps at a gradient of 1:20.
