Proposed Traffic Calming Measures
in Horley Town Centre

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their power under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980, and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police propose to introduce a series of traffic calming measures in the following lengths of road (1) Albert Road (D350) Horley; (2) High Street (D353) Horley; (3) Lumley Road (D351) Horley; and (4) Consort Way East (D1048) Horley. The locations and details of which are specified and described in the Schedule to this Notice.

The amendments outlined above are proposed as part of the Delivering Change in Horley Town Centre programme. More information on the investment in Horley can be found at www.surreycc.gov.uk/horleytowncentre.

Schedule

Albert Road (D350) Horley and High Street (D353) Horley

(1) a flat top raised table, the centreline of which will be located at a point 7.2 metres west of the junction of (D353) High Street and (X9266) Dianna Walk. The proposed raised table will extend across the full width of the carriageway and measure 100mm in height, 12m in length on the inside edge, 18.2m in length on the outside edge and have 1.5 metre ramps at a 1:15 gradient

High Street (D353) Horley

(2) a flat top raised table, the centreline of which will be located at a point 43 metres west of its junction with (D351) Lumley Road. The proposed raised table will extend across the full width of the carriageway and measure 100mm in height, 3m in length and have 1.5 metre ramps at a 1:15 gradient

(3) a flat top raised table, the centreline of which will be located at a point 57 metres east of its junction with (D1048) Consort Way East. The proposed raised table will extend across the full width of the carriageway and measure 100mm in height, 14.4m in length on the inside edge, 19.2m in length on the outside edge and have 1.6m ramps at a 1:16 gradient.

(4) a flat top raised table, the centreline of which will be located at a point 22.5 metres east of its junction with (D1048) Consort Way East. The proposed raised table will extend

across the full width of the carriageway and measure 100mm in height, 4m in length and have 1.6 metre ramps at a 1:16 gradient

Lumley Road (D351) Horley

(5) a flat top road table the centreline of which will be located at a point 3.6 metres north-eastwards from its junction with (D353) High Street. The road table will extend across the full width of the carriageway, will measure 100mm in height and will include a ramp gradient of 1:16 (1.6 metres)

Consort Way East (D1048) Horley

(6) a flat top road table the centreline of which will be located at a point 3.5 metres south-westwards from its junction with (D353) High Street. The road table will extend across the full width of the carriageway, will measure 100mm in height and will include a ramp gradient of 1:15 (1.5 metres)
