

NOTICE
Surrey County Council
Albert Road (D350) Horley
(Prohibition of Entry and Revocation) Order 202-

Surrey County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposed to make the above-mentioned Order. The effect of which will be to:-

- (1) prohibit vehicles, except pedal cycles, proceeding in a northerly direction in Albert Road (D350) Horley from entering that length of the said road situated at a point 190 metres north of its junction with (D353) High Street for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction;
- (2) revoke "The Borough of Reigate and Banstead (Albert Road, Horley) (Part) (One Way Traffic) Order 1985" in its entirety

The prohibition specified in sub-paragraph (1) above will not apply in relation to - (a) a vehicle being used for ambulance fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; (b) anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform; or (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Act.

The amendments outlined above are proposed as part of the Delivering Change in Horley Town Centre programme. More information on the investment in Horley can be found at www.surreycc.gov.uk/horleytowncentre.
