Various Roads in Horsell
(20 mph Speed Limit) Order 202-

Surrey County Council propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 “the Act” (as amended) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to impose a 20mph speed limit in the lengths of roads specified in The Schedule to this Notice. The speed limit proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.

A copy of the proposed Order, a plan showing the lengths of roads to which the Order relates, a Statement of the Council’s reasons for proposing to make the Order and a Statement of the Council’s guidelines on the acceptance of objections to Traffic Regulation Orders may be viewed on-line at

The Schedule

- (a) High Street (C140) Horsell from a point 18m north-west of its junction with Meadway Drive to its junction with Wilson Way;
- (b) Church Hill (C140) Horsell from its junction with Wilson Way to a point 10m south of its junction with Lych Way;
- (c) Meadway Drive (D3647) from its junction with High Street (Horsell) to a point 20m south-west of its southernmost junction with Hammond Road;
- (d) South Close (D3648), its entire length;
- (e) Wilson Way (D3649), its entire length;
- (f) Pares Close (D3649), its entire length;
- (g) Lych Way (D3649), its entire length.
