

A245 KINGSTON ROAD, LEATHERHEAD

PROPOSED RAISED TABLE AND FOOTWAY WIDENING AT EXISTING SIGNALISED CONTROLLED CROSSING

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Surrey County Council is proposing to introduce the following road safety measures on Kingston Road as detailed below

Proposed Road Table

Raised road table extending across the full width of the carriageway for 7.2m across A245 Kingston Road with 1.5m ramps and height of 75mm. Ramps to have a 1 in 20 gradient.

The centre of the existing crossing will be centred on the new raised road table 18.5m south from the centre of Bay Tree Avenue.

Reasoning

The existing signalised controlled pedestrian crossing predominantly serves children and families accessing Leatherhead Trinity Primary School, however following a Road Safety Outside School Audit, it was recommended to both widen the footway either side of the crossing to give pedestrians a larger waiting area; and raise the crossing onto a road table to help reduce vehicle speeds on Kingston Road.

The above proposal will be advertised in the local press (The Surrey Advertiser). County and Borough Councillors, Stakeholders and the Police will be consulted.
