Proposed Traffic Calming Measures in Laleham

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their power under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of traffic calming features in the following roads:

- (a) Shepperton Road (B376) Shepperton/Laleham, the locations of which are specified and described in the First Schedule to this Notice
- (b) Staines Road (B376) Laleham, the locations of which are specified and described in the Second Schedule to this Notice
- (c) The Broadway (B376)/(B377) Laleham; and
- (d) Ashford Road (B377) Laleham;
the locations for part (c) and part (d) are specified and described in the Third Schedule to this Notice.

The proposed road tables will be 75 millimetres in height, 9.75 metres overall in length with a 7.5 metre flat top, with 1.125 metre ramps at a 1:15 gradient across the full width of the carriageway.

The proposed road cushions will be flat-topped and will measure 75 millimetres in height, 3 metres in length and 1.7 metres wide with 600mm long ramp at a gradient of 1:8.

First Schedule

Shepperton Road (B376) Laleham/Shepperton

- (1) a raised table, the centreline of which will be located 13.7 metres southeast from the centre of its junction with Abbey Drive
- (2) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be from a point 58.4 metres northwest from the centre of its junction with Abbey Drive
- (3) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be from a point 14 metres northwest of the south-eastern kerb line in the vicinity of lighting column N15
- (4) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 35.7 metres northeast from the centre of its junction with the access to Laleham Park Nursery
- (5) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 15.1 metres southwest from the centre of its junction with (X6615) Moorhayes Drive
- (6) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 33.1 metres northeast from the centre of the access to the car park of the “Three Horseshoes Public House”

Second Schedule

Staines Road (B376) Laleham

- (1) a raised table, the centreline of which will be 27.3 metres southeast from the common boundary between No.66 Staines Road and No.64 Staines Road
- (2) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be 22.5 metres northwest from the northern boundary of No.32 Staines Road
- (3) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be 31.1 metres southeast from the northern boundary of No.32 Staines Road
- (4) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be 8.5 metres northwest from the common boundary between No.20 Staines Road and No.18 Staines Road

Third Schedule

The Broadway (B376)/(B377) Laleham and Ashford Road (B377) Laleham

- (1) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of the first cushion will be a point approximately 13.5 metres southwest from the centre of its junction with “The Broadway Public Car Park”, the centreline of the second cushion will be a point 17 metres southwest from the centreline of the first cushion on the opposite carriageway.
- (2) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 20.4 metres southwest from the common boundary between the properties known as “Laburnum House” and “No.1 Rose Cottages”
- (3) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 37 metres northeast from the common boundary between the properties known as “Cambridge Cottage” and “Rose Cottage”
- (4) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 35 metres southwest from the common boundary between No.27 Ashford Road and No.29 Ashford Road
- (5) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 50.7 metres northeast from the common boundary between No.27 Ashford Road and No.29 Ashford Road
- (6) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 22 metres southwest from the common boundary between No.65 Ashford Road and No.67 Ashford Road
- (7) a pair of speed cushions, the centreline of which will be a point 30.2 metres northeast from the common boundary between No.75 Ashford Road and No.77 Ashford Road
- (8) a raised table, the centreline of which will be a point 19.9 metres northeast from the common boundary between No.111 Ashford Road and No.113 Ashford Road
