Amendments to Waiting, Loading and Unloading Restrictions and Free On-Street Parking Places and Permit Parking in the Borough of Reigate and Banstead – Linkfield Lane, Redhill

On 29 February 2024 Surrey County Council ("the Council") proposed to make, under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53 of and Part IV to Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), various Orders amending the waiting and parking restrictions in the Borough of Reigate & Banstead. The Council now proposes to make the following Order with further amendments: -

The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Amendment of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and On-Street Parking Places Orders) Order 2018 (Amendment No. 7) Order 202-, the purpose and effect of which will be to make amendments to – (1) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Loading and Unloading and Revocation) Order 2013; (2) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2013; (3) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) Order 2013; and (4) The Surrey County Council (Borough of Reigate and Banstead) On-Street Bus Parking Places Order 2018; so as to make the following changes in Linkfield Lane, Redhill, to facilitate a raised zebra crossing: -

- (a) Prohibit the waiting by vehicles at any time, in certain lengths of the said road, subject to the following exemptions: (1) for loading on and unloading from vehicles; (2) for boarding and alighting from vehicles; (3) using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads specified and the maintenance of those roads and the services in them; (4) for disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the "Blue Badge" scheme;
- (b) Revoke two free on-street parking places Monday-Saturday 8am-6.30pm limited to 30 mins no return within 4 hours;
- (c) Revoke a bus parking place Monday-Friday 8am-10am and 2.30pm-4.30pm.
- (d) Extend and reconfigure a restriction of stopping outside schools between 8.15am and 4.30pm, in the said Linkfield Lane, subject to the usual exemptions, namely any person causing a vehicle to stop in order to avoid an accident if required to do so by law; anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or in accordance with a sign placed by Surrey Police in accordance with Section 66 or 67 of the Act; or any vehicle which is displaying a valid waiver certificate issued by the Council.

Where a new restriction is proposed in this Notice, any existing restrictions on the same length of road shall be revoked.
