Surrey County Council Proposed Raised Zebra Crossing Linkfield Lane (C224) Redhill

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to introduce a raised Zebra Crossing on Linkfield Lane (C224), Redhill, which will be centred 57.7m east of the existing entrance to of St Joseph's Primary School. The crossing will be 4.5m wide on a 6m flat top road table (8.3m including ramp), extending across the full width of the road, 75mm in height with Ramps at a 1:20 gradient.
