Surrey County Council Propose to make the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act of 1984") and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to impose (1) a 30 mph speed limit on the lengths of roads in the First Schedule to this Notice; and (2) a 40 mph speed limit on the length of road in the Second Schedule to this Notice. The speed limits proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.

First Schedule – (1) Littleworth Road (D6835) Claygate from its junction with Oaken Lane westwards for a distance of 50 metres; (2) Littleworth Road (D6835) Claygate from its junction with Oaken Lane northwards for a distance of 40 metres; (3) Oaken Lane (D6827) from its junction with Littleworth Road southwards to street lamp N1; (4) The length of Oaken Lane between street lamp N1 and Manor Road South shall be subject to a 30 mph speed limit by reason of the provision of a system of street lighting, pursuant to Sections 81(1) and 82(1) of the Act of 1984.

Second Schedule - Littleworth Road (D6835) Claygate from its junction with Kingston Bypass (A309) to a point 40 metres north of its junction with Oaken Lane.
