**The Surrey County Council**  
**A23 London Road North, Merstham (Northbound)**  
**(40mph Speed Limit) (Amendment) Order 202-**

Surrey County Council propose to make the above-named Order, under Section 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to:-

- (a) impose a 40mph speed limit on the lengths of roads specified and described in the Schedule to this Notice. The speed limit proposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011;
- (b) carry out legal drafting amendments to “The Borough or Reigate and Banstead (A23 London Road North (Part), Merstham) (50 mph and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1998 so as to amend the existing 50mph Order on the length of A23 London Road North, Merstham as specified and described in part 1 of the Schedule to this Notice.

If you wish to object to, or make representations relating to, the proposed Order, you must send the grounds for your objection or representation (including any in support) by (1) using the online form via the webpage quoted above; or (2) in writing to the undersigned at Hazel House, Merrow Lane, Guildford, Surrey, GU4 7BQ by **20 February 2025**.

**Schedule**

- 1. that length of the northbound carriageway of A23 London Road North, Merstham which extends from its junction with the southbound carriageway of A23 London Road North (in-line with Lamp Column N57), southwards and then south-eastwards to a point 18.5m south-east of the edge of the south-eastern side of the traffic island situated at the junction with D1158 Harps Oak Lane;
- 2. that length of the southernmost arm of D1158 Harps Oak Lane which extends from its southernmost junction with A23 London Road North

- westwards to a point 9.8m west of the edge of the western side of the traffic island situated at the junction with A23 London Road North;
3. that length of the northernmost arm of D1158 Harps Oak Lane which extends from its northernmost junction with A23 London Road North westwards for a distance of 3.9m.
