Proposed Relocation of a Toucan Crossing in Marketfield Way (A23) Redhill

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 23 and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 23(2)(A) of the said Act of 1984, propose to relocate the existing toucan crossing on Marketfield Way (A23) Redhill to a point 24m south of its current location. The crossing will measure 5.2m between the studs.
