## The Surrey County Council Martyrs Lane (D3782) Woodham (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2021

On 7 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above named Order, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers. The effect of the Order, which will come into force on 14 December 2021, will be to impose a 40 mph speed limit on that length of Martyrs Lane (D3782) Woodham as extends from its junction with Woodham Lane (A245) northwards for a distance of 790 metres. The speed limit imposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.
